Subsequently, New Zealand, Costa Rica, Kuwait, Austria, Canada, Belgium, Ireland, Czechia, Lithuania, United Kingdom, complete the list of twenty.

UAE is ranked 22, US at 23, followed by Germany [24], France at 27th rank, Saudi Arab 28th and Singapore 30th.

Japan at 51st place, South Korea at 52nd, Philippines at 53rd, Thailand 58th, Malaysia 59th, Bahrain 62nd, Indonesia 80th, Nepal at 93rd place and Turkey 98th.

The Central Asian countries are also, mostly, ahead of India. It was in the year 2011 that UN General Assembly had adopted a resolution---Happiness: Towards а Holistic Definition of Development and the first World Happiness Report came out in 2012.
